CLASS RANK & GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The graduating class is ranked at the end of the sixth and seventh semesters and this class rank is reported on each student's transcript. The final class rank will be calculated at the end of the seventh semester (close of second marking period). Class rank is based on each student's weighted grade point average. A student's weighted GPA is determined by the assignment of points for grades at each level of course difficulty according to the chart below. Pass/Fail courses and courses with no level designation are not included in the calculation of class rank.

Level 3: Courses at this level are designed for students who already demonstrate a command of skills, are capable of independent study, and are self-motivated. Courses presume proficiency in written expression and critical thinking skills.

Level 4: Courses at this level are designed for students who have the potential for intellectually rigorous study. Students enrolled in these courses have strong writing skills and are capable of high-level critical thinking.

A student's unweighted GPA (4.0 scale) is also calculated at the end of six semesters and is reported on each student's transcript.

*Levels of courses are indicated in the five digit course numbers using the $3^{\rm rd}$ digit:
